
Delivering high-quality education and training across the capital region of Wales.



In our most recent inspections, Estyn – His Majesty's Inspectorate for Education and Training – have provided excellent feedback across all areas of our work.






Our sports academies saw more learners than ever before play for the College, their country, and be crowned national champions.





Pioneers of the Junior Apprenticeship programme in Wales, changing the lives of 14–16-year-olds.




