

More adults than ever before can learn for free with Cardiff and Vale College

Living through the COVID-19 pandemic over the last year has led many adults across the country to reconsider their aspirations and future careers, and Cardiff and Vale College is on hand to help.

Many people have seen their career or the industry they work in negatively impacted and have experienced periods of furlough and uncertainty about the future. Many have had time to reflect on what they really want from the future - maybe taking a step up the career ladder, going it alone with their own business, or training for a brand-new career that offers more security or a better work life balance.

To support adults across the region to achieve their ambitions, Cardiff and Vale College has expanded its offer, with more part-time courses than ever before and more opportunity for adults to gain valuable professional qualifications free of charge.

The College is offering a huge range of courses which span many career areas. Working with employers across the region, the College ensures the qualifications offered fulfil skills requirements now and for the future, supporting key areas of growth for the region that are predicted to see increases in employment opportunities. This includes offering sought after qualifications, which many adults will be able to access for free, across areas including Engineering, Building Services and Construction, Business, Computing and Digital, Hospitality, Health, Care, Teaching and many more. Many qualifications are also new this year including Project Management Prince2®, AgilePM®, SCRUM; Adobe Design Suite and courses in Green Technology.

In a year when many have faced financial challenges, the College, with the support of the Welsh Government, is enabling more adults to learn and gain professional qualifications for free. To find out more, see the feature on page 3 titled 'Could you qualify for a free part-time course?'

To remove further barriers to learning for adults, the College is also offering most courses online and with flexible study so you can undertake qualifications virtually at home, and fit learning around work, family and other commitments. As the first Microsoft Showcase College in the country, CAVC uses a range of simple to use platforms, including Microsoft Teams, so you can attend live sessions with expert teachers from a wide range of industries or access other online resources. You can also benefit from CAVC's award-winning support for learners online, recognised as the top in the UK (see page 4), if you need support with returning to learning or with specific needs.

Over the last year, thousands of adults across Cardiff and the Vale have already boosted their career prospects, accessing qualifications free of charge through the College.

Marta Herrero Martinez, accessed a free Mental Health First Aid course to support her career. She said: "I chose this course because the pandemic meant I was furloughed for a very long time and I just thought it was a perfect opportunity to learn more about mental health. The course was online and divided into webinars. It has helped me a lot to learn how to be more supportive in my role as a manager. If someone asked me if they should do a course I

would say 'yes' because I did it".

Amaris Powell studied Level 3 Teaching and Learning for free to support her career aspiration of working in education. She said: "Applying is really easy – you just go onto the website and it tells you how to do it and there's also a section where you can contact someone who can help you. It was a really easy process.

"I found the course really interesting – I was anxious at first because this was the first time I've done an online course, but my tutor was amazing. She just helped everyone get through and she made everyone comfortable and I just loved the course because there was just so much to learn. There were moments when I thought I wasn't going to be able to finish things on time because I work, but it wasn't an issue because there is a flexible time frame. The skills I have learned from this course have really helped me with my future aspirations. I would recommend it."

Universal Credit/Housing Benefit/Job Seekers Allowance/Carers Allowance/Employment and Support Allowance) access to these FREE OF CHARGE*.

Free courses for employed adults

Many courses offered by CAVC are available through a Personal Learning Account (PLA). A Personal Learning Account (PLA) is funded by Welsh Government to help boost your career. They are simple to set up and allow you to access a huge range of courses and professional qualifications FREE OF CHARGE

Access a PLA if you are aged over 19, living in Wales, employed or self-employed and any one of the below applies to you:

- Earning under £29,534
- Currently on or have been on furlough
- At risk of being made redundant
- Working on a zero-hour contract
- Experienced or likely to experience negative financial impact due to current economic conditions (eg. COVID-19/UK departure from EU).

PLA is not available if you are unemployed, in full-time education or learning and in receipt of ALG or EMA funding.

CAVC support for students awarded the best in the UK

The high level and quality of support that Cardiff and Vale College offers its learners saw the College recently awarded the prestigious TES FE Award for Support for learners.

The support provided by CAVC was judged the best across all colleges in the UK. Alongside the day-to-day support provided by a Course Tutor, the College has invested in expert teams of specialist staff, available to provide individualised wraparound help to support the wellbeing of all students and remove all barriers possible for each student to get the most out of their time at college and reach their potential.

This includes a dedicated team who provide support for learner wellbeing and safeguarding, mental and emotional health, counselling, and dedicated support for vulnerable groups. It includes specialist expert support for learners with additional learning needs, other specific needs or learning coaches to help with study. Teams are also in place to support and advise on financial support.

With all students undertaking some online learning as part of their course, the College has put in place a virtual helpdesk

available to support students to access learning at home. Whilst a dedicated Careers team are available to provide one-to-one support for UCAS applications, applying for jobs and to help all students take their next step.

All this support can be accessed by learners on campus and online, with support teams providing information via a learner portal, the College's own app, providing appointments via Microsoft Teams and through email, phone and livechat.

Kay Martin, Principal of Cardiff and Vale College said "We are committed to providing the best support possible for all of our students. To be recognised for this during a year when supporting our learners has never been more important, is a testament to our fantastic staff".

CAVC increases opportunities and support for students from Welsh speaking schools

Cardiff and Vale College has boosted opportunities for students coming from Welsh schools across the region to continue learning bilingually and through the medium of Welsh.

As part of its commitment to further strengthening its Welsh curriculum, the College has bolstered its offer by adding dedicated Welsh medium and bilingual pathways in areas such as Children's Care, Public Services and Sport, alongside enabling learners to be assessed in Welsh, whatever subject they are studying. A programme of support to enable students to take the language through their lives and into their future careers is also in place.

From Welsh Ambassadors – a team of Welsh speaking students in place to offer a wide range of Welsh medium extra-curricular opportunities and support their peers - to Welsh Champions - Welsh speaking teachers from different curriculum areas in place to help, support and further develop Welsh across CAVC - a number of new initiatives have been launched to support students wanting to continue using their Welsh in a college setting.

Katie Hill, one of the Welsh Ambassadors and winner of the College's Outstanding Commitment to the Welsh Language award sponsored by Coleg Cymraeg Cenedlaethol, is studying A Levels at CAVC and has found the College to be a great support of her language skills; "The College is 100% helping me achieve my goals. I have never been in an educational system that is so supportive of not only my future, but right now in the present moment as well.

"As someone who was in primary and secondary school in a Welsh medium, moving somewhere English based is very intimidating but I believe the integration has been amazing here at the College.

"I think what I've enjoyed the most about being in college is the ability to promote the Welsh language and not only be able to show students that it can be taken further into education but it can also be used for fun."

Amazing achievements in an extraordinary year

Despite facing a year unlike any other, Cardiff and Vale College students continued to shine.

From securing leading university places and top employment opportunities, to being awarded the best in their industry at what they do. From representing their country in their chosen sport to a host of other amazing individual achievements, CAVC has supported its students to stand out and get noticed.

Each year, hundreds of CAVC students apply for and progress to university, securing top university places across the UK and internationally. A Levels student Oscar Griffin, with the support of the College's A Level Scholars Programme, gained a place studying Classics at Cambridge University for September. Oscar was one of the first cohort to study Classics at A Level in CAVC, when it started offering the course two years ago.

"My teachers are really engaged and passionate about their subjects, especially my Classical Civilisations teacher Danny, who pushed me to apply and helped me through the process, and my Form Tutor Matthew, who must have done something right with my reference," he said. "Studying at CAVC comes with a lot of independence, making it feel more like a university already."

Many CAVC students have also chosen to progress straight into employment following their course, securing excellent jobs across a wide range of sectors. Evelina Sinkeviciute, who studied Financial Studies, Securities and Investment, a full-time course that combines certificates from both the Chartered Institute for Securities and Investment and the London Institute of Banking and Finance, achieved A's across all her exams and went straight from her course to a job as a Business Support Analyst at Deloitte

Through the year, the College continued to support students to compete in a raft of industry skills competitions, with many proving themselves to being among the best of the best in their sector. Electrotechnical Apprentice Kaiden Ashun was named the best in the UK, winning Screwfix Trade Apprentice 2021, while Journalism apprentice Jack Grey was commended for Top Scoop for his coverage of the Colston statue protests in Bristol, which was beamed around the world.

CAVC students also achieved an impressive haul of 30 medals in Skills Competition Wales, gaining a record 14 gold, seven silver and nine bronze across sectors including Culinary Arts, Automotive, Forensic Science, Cyber Security, Enterprise, 3D Game Design, Horticulture and Hairdressing. The competitions see learners train with their industry expert teachers in the College's specialist facilities, offering the opportunity to be recognised as the best in Wales at what they do, with many chosen to represent the country at WorldSkills. The competitions further the students skills, confidence, and provide experiences that help them stand out and secure university and career progression.

BTEC Extended Diploma in 3D Design learner James Roberts won gold in 3D Game Design. He said: "It's a great feeling having won a gold medal. I'm looking forward to progressing on to WorldSkills and challenging myself further."

Other students have taken advantage of other CAVC programmes alongside their course to help them achieve their dreams

- from industry mentoring and coaching, to be a part of one of CAVC's renowned sports academies. Around 70 students participated in the Career Ready programme through the year, a UK-wide initiative the College has partnered with for many years to link leading employers with students to provide mentoring, masterclasses, workplace visits and internships. Previous learners have secured future employment and leading university places through the programme, that this year included online internships in national companies including Accenture. Wedlake Bell, Isio, Portland, Cirkle, AIG, BP, KMF and Marsh & McLennan.

Montanna-Marie Morris-Gallimore completed an online internship with London-based marketing firm KMF Group as part of the Career Ready programme, which she undertook alongside her A Levels. "My virtual experience was amazing, being given the chance to work with a national company in London and work closely with professionals gave me an eye opener into what the future could hold," she said. "Although I wasn't able to be inside the company's building to see how everything runs due to COVID, communicating with members of KMF and completing tasks set by them, really put me into business mode. Having already thought about opening up my own company in the future, this inspiring experience has shed light on some of the steps needed to take in order to achieve my goals."

Despite the disruption caused by the pandemic to sport across the country, CAVC's renowned sports academies continued to work with students to progress their skills and ambitions in their chosen sport, alongside their studies. CAVC has dedicated academies for Rugby, Football, Cricket and Netball, which students on any course can trial for

and be a part of alongside their studies, to meet their academic and sporting goals. Former students and CAVC Rugby Academy players Nathan Evans, Construction, Jake Beetham and Evan Lloyd, both A Levels, were all selected to play for Wales U20 Six Nations. The CAVC Rugby Academy also saw its first captain and former A Level student at the College, Ben Thomas, selected for Wales senior squad, for their summer campaign against Canada and Argentina. Members of the cricket, football and netball academies also gained selection for high profile teams including Wales U18s during the year.

Sharon James, Deputy Principal of Cardiff and Vale College said, "It's about more than just qualifications at CAVC. Alongside supporting students to reach their potential on their course, the College prides itself on the additional experiences it can offer students to help them develop their skills and follow their dreams, and there was never going to be any chance of a pandemic getting in the way of that. The students' achievements speak for themselves and we are so incredibly proud of what each and every one achieved during this extraordinary year".













As the first college in Wales to go through a Quality Assurance Agency for Higher Education (QAA) Gateway Review, CAVC has been able to build its portfolio of career-focused courses year on year. Alongside providing its own Higher Education courses, the College works with a network of partner universities from across the UK to bring additional HE opportunities to the Capital Region.

This year the College is launching a new HNC and HND in Engineering, with career pathways in Mechanics, Engineering, Electric and Electronic and Manufacturing.

Other courses include HNDs in Business, Construction & Built Environment and Aeronautical Engineering, building on the College's successful track record of training for these

industries. There are two degrees that are highly regarded in the music industry – the BA in Electronic Music Production and the BMus in Music Recording and Performance. Plus, the innovative BSc in Cyber Security opens doors to careers in many sectors.

As the first and only Microsoft Showcase College in Wales, CAVC lecturers are proven to be able to deliver high quality online learning, whatever the situation.

It also pays to be an HE student at CAVC - offering real value for money with the opportunity to save up to £3,000 on fees, and access grants to make studying HE at CAVC more affordable than ever before. Travel and accommodation costs are also lower when you study locally, providing further savings.

And the College has excellent success rates across its Higher Education courses – producing some top-class results. For example, at CAVC's International Centre for Aerospace Training (ICAT), for two consecutive years most learners studying the BEng Aircraft Engineering have gained First Class Honours degrees, many progressing from studying Aerospace courses at the College, with the option of taking A Levels in Maths, Further Maths or Physics to support their progression to top universities.


